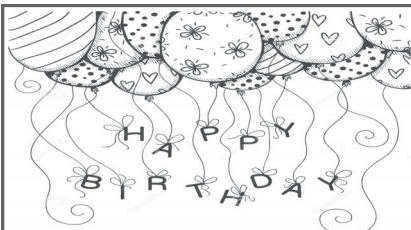

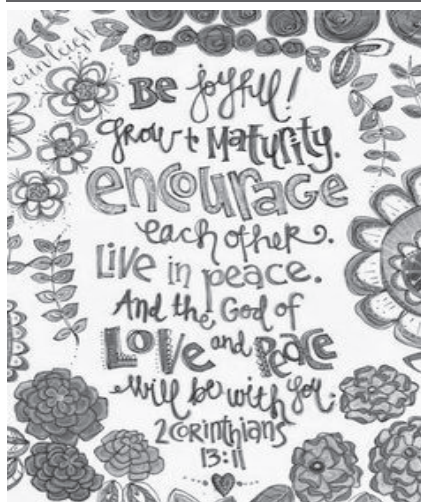

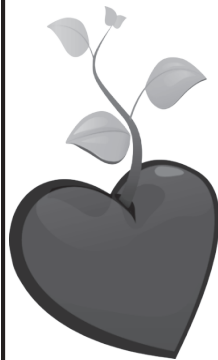

Pastor's Message

I love when we sing the hymn, "Wherever He Leads, I'll Go." And while singing is great, living the truth of those words is an even greater blessing. The history of this great hymn goes back to a simple conversation between Reverend and Missionary R. S. Jones and Southern Baptist songwriter B. B. McKinney. Due to poor health issues, Jones was forced to return from missionary service in Brazil. While visiting one evening Jones revealed to McKinney that his doctors would not allow him to return to South America. When asked about his future plans the missionary said, "I don't know, but wherever He leads I'll go." Those words echoed in McKinney's mind. It didn't take long for him to write both the words and music of this great hymn.

In Revelation 14:4 we read, "...These are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever He goeth. These were redeemed from among men, being the firstfruits unto God and to the Lamb." During the Tribulation, these 144,000 witnesses will follow the Christ's leading wherever He goes. We, too, are called to live out these Words of Truth today. Jesus is going into all parts of this broken world with a message of hope, forgiveness, mercy and grace. He calls each of us to take up our cross and follow Him.
